


Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of March 2 shows continued expansion of drought conditions. Since early February, drought has expanded 9 percentage points. With little precipitation forecast for the next week, we can expect additional drought expansion on next week's map.

Drought conditions

- ♦ 51% a week ago
- ♦ 79% three months ago
- ♦ 21% a year ago





February precipitation

Some locations in Texas received record amounts of snow in February. But snow is mostly air. It takes as much as 10 to 12 inches of fresh snow to provide an inch of moisture. Despite the snow, most of the state received below average moisture for the month.
