## Water conditions

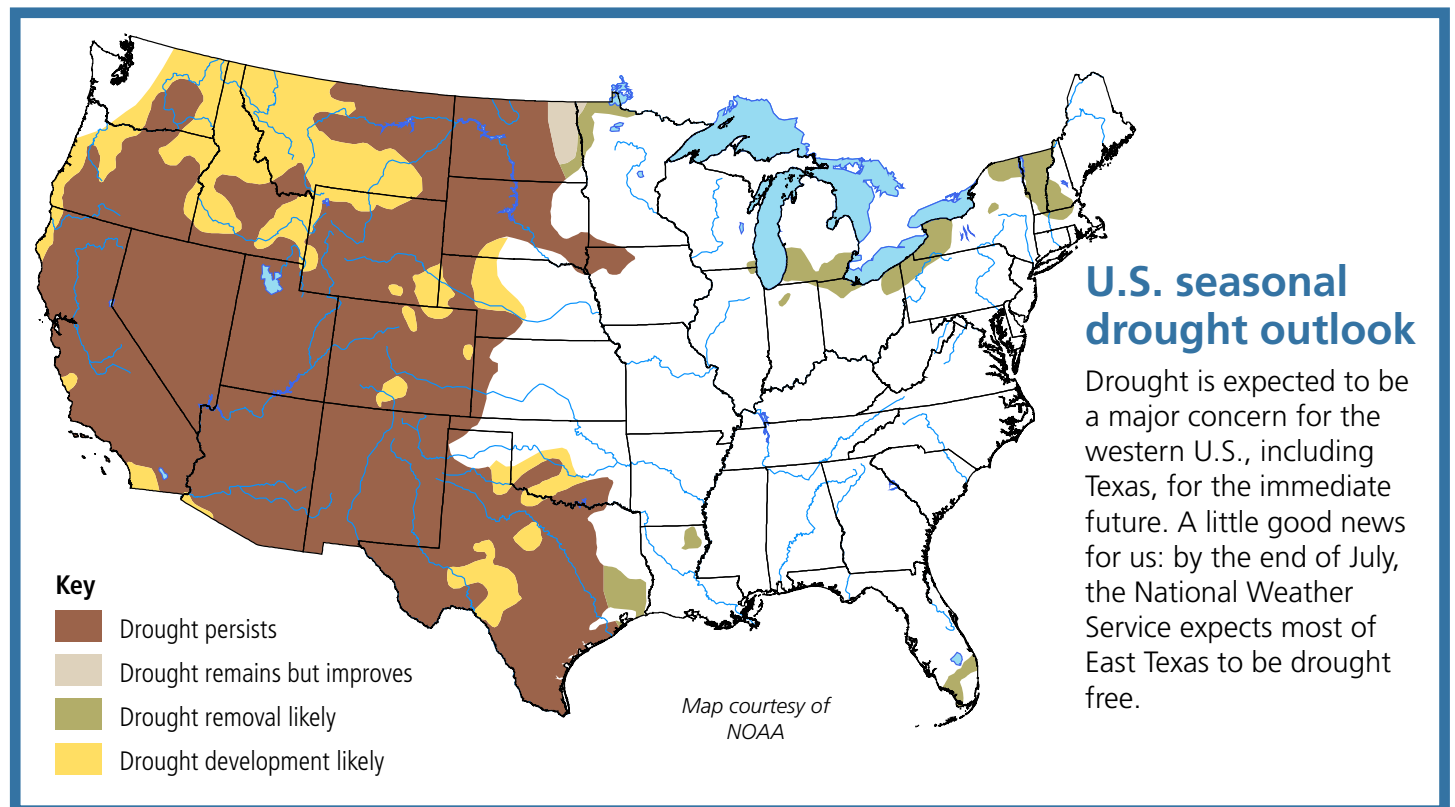
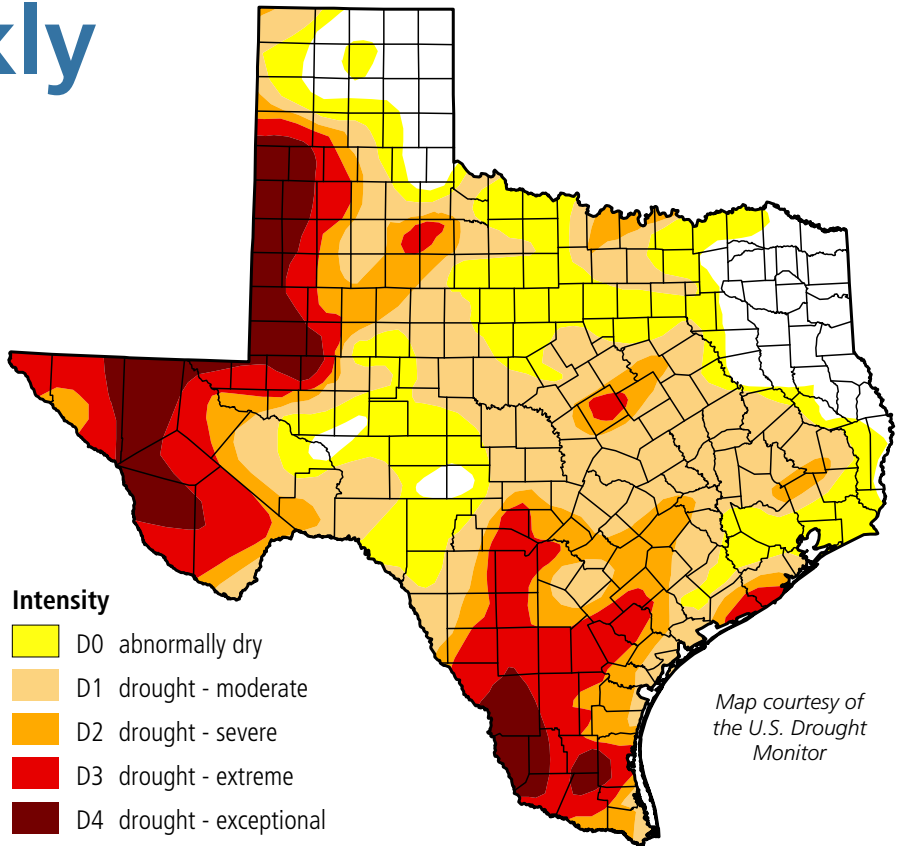
The latest drought map for conditions as of April 20 shows the largest one-week improvement since early January. Large areas, particularly in the northeast quarter of the state, experienced a one-class improvement in drought conditions. That same part of the state could see additional improvements in the next week.

## Drought conditions

- ◆ 67% now
- ◆ 75% a week ago
- ◆ 49% three months ago
- ◆ 16% a year ago

### Intensity

- ◆ D0 abnormally dry
- ◆ D1 drought - moderate
- ◆ D2 drought - severe
- ◆ D3 drought - extreme
- ◆ D4 drought - exceptional
