


# Water Weekly

## Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of January 12 shows continued improvement. In the last two weeks, the area of the state impacted by drought has decreased by 33 percentage points. For the first time since early November 2020, less than half the state is in drought.



## Drought conditions


- ◆ 48% now
- ◆ 58% a week ago
- ◆ 36% three months ago
- ◆ 37% a year ago

### Intensity

- ◆ D0 abnormally dry
- ◆ D1 drought - moderate
- ◆ D2 drought - severe
- ◆ D3 drought - extreme
- ◆ D4 drought - exceptional

## Presidio County percent area

Drought remains firmly entrenched in Presidio County and other parts of West Texas. 2020 was the third hottest and fourth driest year for the county in 127 years. Moderate or worse drought has been present in the county every week since May, and exceptional drought has been present since August.
